

A RESOLUTION OF THE FERRY COUNTY HEALTH BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, REPUBLIC WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE HOSPITAL TO USE THE SMALL WORKS ROSTER AND COMPETITIVE BID PROCESS FOR PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, RCW 70.44.140(2) authorizes public hospital districts to use a small works roster.

WHEREAS, if a project has an estimated cost over \$75,000 and under \$300,000, hospital will use small works roster. (RCW 39.04.155)

WHEREAS, the small works roster will be maintained locally by Ferry County Health.

WHEREAS, Small Works rosters are less restrictive and time-consuming than full formal competitive bids.

WHEREAS, Competitive Bid Process will be used on any project with an estimated cost over \$300,000.

WHEREAS, Request for Proposal (RFP) will be used for all projects outside of ordinary maintenance. Ordinary maintenance includes but is not limited to work performed by staff of the hospital and any projects with an estimated cost below \$10,000.

WHEREAS, Hospital will follow prevailing wage requirements.

WHEREAS, Performance bonds are required for any project above \$50,000.
